Monthly Report of P B Garland for materials used on side walks and crossings during the month of Nov was read accepted and ordered filed.

An Ordinance prohibiting the discharge of Fire arms within the Incorporation passed 1<sup>st</sup> reading Motion of Coates that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and final passage seconded by Pransue and carried by the following vote, yeas Morgan Probst Webb Coates Pransue yeas 5. nays 0. The Ordinance then passed 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 5 nays 0. The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed.
