Council convened at regular session

Morgan was made clerk for the
evening. The Minutes of last meeting
was read and approved.The Solicitor read the ordinance
fixing the rate of taxation and distri-
bution of the same for the year 1880
the same was approved.Trause moved that the rules be
suspended and the ordinance passed to
its third reading all the members present
voting in the affirmative.Motion of Coates that the ordinance for
revision of laws governing the fire Dept
be postponed until next meeting.Motion of Webb that City Solicitor see
Mr Griewood asst General Manager of P. B. O.
& C. RR requesting him to kindly favor
the City by having a plank walk laid on
the crossing a depot and also at the same
time return the thanks of the Council
for the excellent plank crossing he has
laid across the RR at Mt Union St.The committee's Report on Gas pipes
asked to be continued which was allowed.
Mr Suttwell reported necessity for a number
of new sidewalks, and repairs to a number
of others, all of which were ordered and
