

## Council Room

Alliance Ohio June 7 1880

Council convened in regular session Mayor Johnson presiding Roll called, present, Morgan, Stillwell, Webb, Coates Traume, Mercer

Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Petition of citizens asking for gasoline lamp post on corner of Linden Ave and Cambridge Street was read on motion of Traume seconded by Webb was referred to Gas committee with power to act

Mayor's Report of fines and licenses for part of the month of April and month of May amounting to \$96<sup>28</sup> was read on Motion of Coates seconded by Stillwell accepted and ordered filed.

An Ordinance to repeal Sections 11, 13, 16, 23, 27, 28, 30 and 35 of First Ordinance was read. Motion of Mercer that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass second reading seconded by Coates and carried by the following vote. Yeas Morgan Stillwell Webb Coates Traume Mercer. Yeas 6 Nays.

G B W Coates chairman of side walk committee to whom was referred the matter of hiring some suitable person to lay side walks and crossings for the ensuing year reported that they had employed P B Garland, at \$1<sup>50</sup> per day on motion of Webb seconded by Morgan the Report was adopted.

The committee to whom was referred the matter of hiring a teamster to serve the ensuing year Reported as follows

It has employed St J. Beardley to serve as teamster for the ensuing year for \$1<sup>25</sup> per day for six months and for \$1<sup>00</sup> for the remainder of the year.

B S Mercer, Frank Trause, J B Morgan  
Street Committee, on motion of Stebb  
seconded by Coates reported was adopted.

The following report was read.

Mr Mayor your committee on  
gas and lighting city report as follows,  
we have contracted with Alliance gas &  
oke co. to light and keep in repair the  
gas lamps at \$2.30 for each post per month  
also with W B Love to furnish gasoline  
keep in repair and light gasoline lamps  
at \$1.20 each per month.

Motion of Coates seconded by Stebb that the Bill  
A J L Bell be referred back to street committee

with power to act. The following Resolution was offered by Mr Suttwell seconded by Coates that new walks be laid South of Broadway on East Liberty Street in front of Lots No. 154 155, 420 421, 422, 465 and 466 on the West side of North Broadway in front of Lot 162 and also that the walk be repaired in Liberty Street in front of Lots No 34, 35 & 36. Resolution was adopted.

A Communication from C & P RR's Chief of Police asking that all trunks and trunks emptying upon their property be removed at once, was read. Motion of Stebb seconded by Suttwell that the matter be referred to Street Committee.

It was recommended by J M Stebb that that the Fire Committee be instructed to procure a heater for Town Searer. Motion of Stebb seconded by Suttwell that the matter be referred to Fire Committee. Mr Bowen called the attention of the Council to the bad condition of the well at corner of Broadway and Linden Avenue. Motion of Franzen seconded by Morgan that the matter be referred to Fire Committee.

Motion of Morgan seconded by Coates that the Street Committee be instructed to purchase such blank books as necessary for their use, also for use of Street Commissioner. Carried.

Motion of Suttwell seconded by Coates that the Clerk be instructed to procure procure order books for use of Council.

There being no further business Council adjourned.
