Report of P. B. Sarland for materials used on side walks and crossing during the month of June, on motion of was accepted and ordered filed.

An Ordinance to provide for the laying of sidewalk and furnishing the width and material for side walks upon Patterson St from Mechanic Street to East Corporation Line, passed 1<sup>st</sup> reading. Motion of Coates that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> reading and final passage seconded by Sillwell and carried by the following vote, yeas Morgan Sillwell Webb Coates Transue Mercer. The ordinance then passed 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 6 nays 0.

The Mayor then declared the ordinance duly passed.

An Ordinance providing for the laying of side walks and furnishing the width <sup>and</sup> of material for side-walks upon Grant Street from Mount-Union Street to Linden Ave passed 1<sup>st</sup> reading Motion of Sittwell that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and final passage, seconded by Morgan and carried by the following vote yeas Morgan Sittwell Herb Coelet Trainor Mercer The Ordinance then passed 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 6 nays 0. The Mayor declared the ordinance duly passed.
