Bond of Solomon Berlin as night Policeman with R. A. Pectors & William Bastetter as sureties was read. Motion of Trausne seconded by Mercer that Bond be accepted, The yeas and nays being called resulted as follows, yeas Townsend Stillwell Beardsley Coates Trausne Mercer yeas 6 nays.

Bond of Jas. & Hoque as night Policeman with L. Fording and A. C. Silvers as sureties was read. Motion of Beardsley seconded by Stillwell that Bond be accepted, the yeas & nays being called resulted in a unanimous vote yeas 6 nays 0.

Motion of Coates seconded by Stillwell that the side walks on Arch Street be repaired from Alliance Street to Rosenberg Street

Motion of Beardsley seconded by Mercer that the sidewalks on South side of Broadway be repaired from Liberty Street East to C & P RR also the walk on Liberty Street from Broadway as far as they extend

Motion of Stillwell seconded by Beardsley that sidewalks be repaired on North Walnut Street

Motion of Coates seconded by Pransue that walks on Mt Union Street be repaired beginning at Ely Street and extending South to Corporation Limits also the walks on Park Street

Motion of Coates seconded by Pransue that Gas Committee be instructed to locate a gasoline lamp post this side of Kirks mill between the two bridges.

Motion of Pransue seconded by Beardsley that the walks on Ludlow Avenue be repaired from Alliance Street to Rosenberg Street
