Co over certain streets & alleys of the Incorporated Village of Alliance and providing condition upon which the same may be enjoyed, had previously passed 1st reading motion of Mercer that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2nd & 3rd reading and final passage, seconded by Transue and carried by the following vote
 yeas Townsend Sittwell Boardley Coates Mercer, nays Transue, yeas 5 nays 1.
 The ordinance then passed 2nd & 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood as before, yeas 5 nays 1. The Mayor declared the ordinance duly passed.

Motion of Mercer seconded by Transue that the matter in regard to laying sidewalk in front of Daniel Heibarts property at corner of Alliance and Freedom Street.
