City Council Record

City of Alliance Ohio June 20, 1881
Council convened in regular session.

Mayor Johnson presiding. Roll called.
Present: Councilmen Boardman
Boyer, Brown, about. Absent.

Minutes of last meeting read and
approved.

The City solicitor stated that he
had examined the well at corner of Bridge
and S. Broadway, and was of the opinion
that the present drain was sufficient and
advised the Council to take no further
action in the matter. Moved by Tranese
seconded by Boardman that the report
be accepted.

An Ordinance to provide for the const-
tution and repair of sidewalks was passed &
remains for the City of Alliance to be

be authorized to present the Ordinance to pass
 2nd & 3rd reading and final passage seconded
 by Coates and carried by the following vote
 Yeas 5 nays 0 the ordinance then passed 2nd &
 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood
 as before Yeas 5 nays 0. The Mayor declared the
 ordinance duly passed.

A communication from J. S. Garrison was made
 asking that his bid for doing the City printing
 which was presented some months ago and
 referred to Finance Committee be brought up
 and acted upon on motion the Finance
 Committee were instructed to report at
 next meeting.

City Marshal Johnson reported that a
 number of persons had served five years
 in the fire dept but had received no certificate
 exempting them from paying poll tax and
 asked the Council to instruct him what to
 do in these cases upon motion of Coates
 seconded by Coates that the Mayor and
 Chief Engineer were requested to give cer-
 tificates to such persons upon their furnishing
 satisfactory evidence that they had served
 five years in Fire Department.

Mr. Bondow asked in behalf
 of the Catholic Church that their
 petition, presented some time last summer
 for the vacation of the alley between the Catholic
 Church buildings be granted motion of Coates
 seconded by Boardley that the matter be
 referred to Committee on Streets and alleys.

Motion of Coates seconded by Boardley
 that Finance Committee be instructed to furnish
 12 doz order books for use of Council.

The bills of J. S. Garrison and J. S. White
 for doing town printing were reported.
