Council met in regular session Mayor Johnson being absent. It was moved by Townsend and seconded by Boardley that Mr Coates act as chairman for the evening. Roll called. Townsend Stillwell Boardley Coates Simon Mercer. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

A communication from Mrs E. C. Coates calling the attention of the Council to the necessity of a bridge in the alley on the South side of Ely Street near Mt Union Street was read. she claimed that the floods would soon wash away her out houses and stone wall - and that teams can scarcely pass.

Motion of Trammes seconded by Townsend that the matter be referred to committee on streets and alleys.

The following Resolution was offered by Mr Beardsly - Be it resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio that the owner of Lot No 119 in Pectors addition to the village of Alliance Ohio be and are hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice ^{to him} of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk on the east side of Linden Ave in front of Lot 119 in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Linden Ave in said village said sidewalk shall be six ft wide and shall be constructed of either brick or stone seconded by Stillwell and carried by the following vote yeas Townsend Stillwell Beardsly Coates Trammes Mercer yeas 5 nays 0. The Mayor declared the Resolution duly passed.

The following Resolution was offered and adopted. Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio that the owner of part Lot no 47 in E Pectors addition to the village of Alliance Ohio be and they are now hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk in front of the eighteen ft east part of Lot no 47 in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed

by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Alliance Street in said village that said side walk shall be sixteen ft wide and constructed of stone or brick.

The yeas and nays being called resulted as follows yeas 6 nays 0. The mayor declared the Resolution duly passed.

The following Resolution was offered by Mr. Transue - Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated village of Alliance Ohio that the owner of Lot No 52 in Section addition to the village of Alliance Ohio, be and is now hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk at a place abutting as herein described on Lot No 52 in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Alliance Street that said side walk shall be sixteen ft wide and constructed of stone commencing at a point 20 in west of the South west corner of the building on said Lot No 52 in said addition thence South 16 ft West 9 ft 8 1/4 in thence North 16 ft thence East 9 ft and 4 in to place of beginning. The yeas and nays being called on the above Resolution resulted as follows yeas 6 nays 0. Sillwell Boardley located Transue Mercer yeas 6 nays 0. The Mayor declared the Resolution duly passed.
