Alliance Ohio Nov 12, 1851.

Council convened in regular session.

Mayor Johnson presiding Roll called.  
Present. Townsend, Stillwell, Beardsley,  
Coates, Mercer, absent. Transmitt.

Motion of Mercer seconded by Townsend road and approved.  
The Street committee to whom was referred the petition of Thomas Johnson asking that he be allowed the privilege of erecting a covering over his fish stand in the public square Reported that they did not deem it advisable for the reason that others would expect similar favors and structures of this kind be more or less of an obnoxious nuisance of Stillwell seconded by Townsend report was accepted.

Mr Coates reported that the Finance Committee had not yet settled with Mr Kirk for the gravel which had been hauled for the use of the City and asked for further time which was granted.

Motion of Mercer seconded by Townsend that the gas com be instructed to look up the matter of locating a gas post on Arch Street north of the Pittsburg Post Office and Chicago P. O. in the vicinity of W. B. Marshall's.

Motion of Mercer seconded by Coates.

passed to 1<sup>st</sup> reading an ordinance to provide for  
 the labor of persons convicted of violation of Ordinances  
 of the Incorporated Village of Alliance during their  
 term of imprisonment and the place and manner  
 of such labor. Motion of Coates seconded by Beardsley  
 that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance  
 to pass 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and final passage, carried  
 by the following vote, yeas Townsend, Stillwell  
 Beardsley, Coates Mercer, yeas 5, nays 0. The or-  
 dinance then passed 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and vote  
 on its final stood as before, yeas 5 nays 0.

The Mayor declared the ordinance duly  
 passed. Motion of Stillwell seconded  
 by Mercer that the roof of the City prison be  
 given a coat of paint, on motion referred to  
 Building Com. Motion of Mercer seconded  
 by Beardsley that the Prison Com be instructed  
 to purchase the necessary balls and chains  
 for the working of prisoners as provided  
 for in the ordinance just passed.

Mr. Florian Marchand was present and  
 asked that he be granted a yearly licence  
 for the performances in the opera house  
 was referred to Finance Com with power to act.

No further business Council
