Council convened in regular session

Mayor Johnson presiding Rott called Present Townsend Stillwell Beardsley Coates Transue Mercer.

Minutes read and approved.

Mayors report of fine licenses for month of Feb. Am't to 23⁷⁰ also 25⁰⁰ days work on Streets and prisoners. Motion of Transue seconded by Townsend Report was accepted and ordered filed.

Petition of Citizens asking that a lamp post be placed at the corner of Arch Street and Grant and corner of Arch and Rosenberg St also to put in proper condition the side walk on South side of Grant Street Motion of Coates seconded by Beardsley report was referred to Gas and sidewalk Com.

A Petition signed by a number of Citizens asking for the opening of Cambridge Street and that it be put in proper condition for travel. Motion of Coates seconded by Mercer Report was referred to Street Co.

The following report of Police Committee was read.

Whereas complaint has been made before this body accusing James Hoque and Solomon Berlin, Policemen, of conduct unbecoming gentlemen and officers. Said charges being brought to the notice of this body at its last meeting Dec 6 1882 on complaint of Isaac Beck And Whereas the said Isaac Beck has failed to appear and substantiate the above charges at the time set by this Council for their investigation to wit Dec 20 1882. he being duly notified to do so. Therefore be it Resolved that the members of this Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance do hereby entirely exonerate James Hoque and Solomon Berlin from any blame as officers or gentleman and we think the above charges were conceived in malice and were intended to injure said Policemen in the estimation of the Council and the Citizens of the town which charges in our estimation are false and without foundation.

Motion of Townsend that orders be drawn on the Treasury out of the different funds as read seconded by Beardsley and carried by the following vote year Townsend Stillwell Beardsley Coates Truman Mercer year 6 nays 0

The Bill of Geo Heritman for damage to property by falling in Rosenberg Street was on Motion of Mercer seconded by Truman referred to City Solicitor

An Ordinance granting permission to erect and maintain a system of telephones or telephone exchange for Incorporated Village of Alliance on Motion of Mr Mercer passed to 1st reading Motion of Coates that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass 2nd 3rd reading and final passage seconded by Beardsley and carried by the following vote year Townsend Stillwell Beardsley Coates Truman Mercer The ordinance thus passed.

2nd and 3rd reading and the vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 6 nays 0. The Mayor then declared the Ordinance duly passed.

Moved by Beardsley seconded by Trammell that Mayor be authorized to have a telephone put up for the use of the City officials. The Resolution was carried.

The following Resolutions were read
Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance O. that the owner of Lot No 47 in Tractors addition to the village of Alliance be and is hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice to him of the passage of this Resolution to construct a side walk on the South side being part of 18 ft of Lot 47 in the Addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the Ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Alliance Street and said side-walk shall be 16 ft wide and constructed of stone or brick.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance O. that the owner of Lot No. in Tractors addition to the village of Alliance be and is hereby required and ordered to within sixty days after due notice to him of the passage of this Resolution to construct a side walk in front of the block or square of land abutting on the 1st Street North of the Union School house said side walk to be built on the East side of said Lot abutting on Park Street in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Park Street in said village. That side walk shall be 6 ft wide and constructed of brick or stone.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio.

That the owners of Lot No. 13 in Reesters addition to the village of Alliance be and is hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice to her of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk on the South East side of Lot No 13 in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the Ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Fourth Street in said village. That said side walk shall be six ft wide and constructed of stone or brick. Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio That the owner of Lot No 49 in Reesters Addition to the village be and is now hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice to him of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk on the South East of Lot No 49 in the addition aforesaid upon the Elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Fourth St in said village. That said side walk shall be 6 ft wide and constructed of brick or stone.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated village of Alliance that the owner of Lot No 47 in Doctors Addition to the village of Alliance be and is now hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice to him of the passage of this Resolution to construct a sidewalk on the South side of 14 ft front of Lot 47 in the addition aforesaid upon the elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Alliance Street in said village. That said sidewalk shall be 12 ft wide and constructed of brick or stone.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio that the owner of Lots No 250 & 251 in Tector's and Lamborn's addition to the village of Alliance is now hereby required and ordered within sixty days after due notice to him of the passage of this Resolution to construct a side walk on the North side of Lots 250 & 251 in addition aforesaid upon the Elevation fixed by the Ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Patterson Street in said Village That said side walk shall be 6 ft wide and constructed of Stone or Brick.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio That the owner of Lot 37 in Tector's addition to the village of Alliance be and is hereby required and ordered within sixty days after the passage of this Resolution to construct a side walk on the South Side of Lot No 37 in the addition aforesaid upon the Elevation fixed by the ordinance now in force providing and establishing a grade on Alliance St in said village. That said side walk shall be 16 ft wide and constructed of Stone or brick. It was moved by Coates seconded by Mercer that the resolutions be accepted.
