Council Convened in regular Session

Mayor Johnson Presiding

Roll Called. Present, Townsend, Stillwell
Beardsley, Coats, Trausue, & Mercer.

The minutes of the last meeting read
and on Motion Approved.

Mr Mercer stated that the Prison Comm-
ittee had discussed the question with the
Township Trustees in regard to rent

failed to make an agreement.

The Mayor then admin-

On motion of Coats. Seconded by Townsend that the Salaries of the Police officers for the present year remain the same as the last year. Yeas & Nays Called, Yeas Lee, Shaffer, Ruth, Coats, Beardsley, & Townsend. Yeas 6 Nays 0. Mayor declared the Motion past.

The Mayor presented the names of James Hogue, Solomon Berlin & Thos Casselman as Candidates for the office of Police. The Yeas and Nays being Called for each Candidate Separately resulted, as follows Yeas - Lee, Shaffer, Ruth, Coats, Beardsley & Townsend, Yeas 6, Nays None. Mayor declared the said Candidates duly Elected.

On Motion of Townsend and Seconded by Beardsley that the following Resolution was Passed

Resolved, that the Marshal of the Incorporated Village of Alliance be ordered to notify, by Printed Posters all Persons to at once provide Muzzles for Dog or Dogs of such Owner or owners Allowed by them to run at large That after few days publication of such notice, the Marshal and Police are ordered and required to Kill and destroy all Dogs found unmuzzled on the Streets or Allies unaccompanied by their Owner or Keeper.

The following resolution was offered by Mr Townsend. which was read and on Motion of Beardsley seconded by Coats was Past. Resolved that the Printings of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Street this year as last and that the Clerk be requested to furnish each Editor with a copy of the Proceedings of the Council.

On motion of Townsend seconded by Beardsley that Sidewalks be repaired on the following Streets. On the North Side of Lots No 125, 124, & 418 Broadway. Owned by Robert Dunn - Also on the South East Side of Lot 49 - 4th Street Hoesters Addition belonging to Mr Wise. - On the South Side lots No 22 & 23 Patterson Street in Webbs Addition Owned by Lawrence Rickard - And on the East Side of Lot No 249 Patterson Street in Seters & Lamborn's Addition Owned by George Rosenberry. And on the South Side of Lot No 139 Market Street in Seters Addition, James Woods, Agent.
