Report of

on Water works

To the Mayor and Council of  
the Village of Alliance  
Gentlemen

Having been appointed a Committee  
of Conference by the Citizens of this Town  
we respectfully submit the following  
Suggestions and Modifications to the  
proposals made by Messrs J. A. Cloud & Co  
Water Works Building Contractors  
First - That no Exclusive Privilege  
can be legally given, nor any Taxes  
be remitted.

2<sup>nd</sup>. That you require the Main  
Pipe laid from the Pumping Station  
to the Stand Pipe to be of Sufficient  
Size to Supply a City or Town of  
Twenty Thousand Inhabitants, and  
that at the intersection of each Street  
there shall be an Opening in  
order that Connections be made  
with the least possible delay  
and inconvenience to the Public

And further, that no pipe shall  
be used that has not been tested  
to withstand a pressure of three  
Hundred Pounds to the Square inch  
And further That All mains, branches  
and Pipes, shall be made with

Load joints. We would also recommend that the Mains be laid in such streets as will best subserve the Public. Also that there shall be Valves on each street at the point of connection with the main pipe for the convenience of repairs or Extensions. And further: that, there shall be two sets of Pumping Engines that there need be no <sup>stoppage or</sup> delay in the supply of water after the works are completed.

We would after careful consideration recommend that there be not less than three Miles of Pipe laid and to give proper Protection against fire that you cause thirty Fire Hydrants to be Erected and at such Points as may be determined by you at a cost which we have been able to reduce from \$3000 per Annum to \$2500.
