Council Convened in regular Session

Mayor Johnson Presiding

Present on Roll Call See ~~Shaffer~~ Ruth
Coats, Beardsley & Townsend.Minutes of last Meeting
read and approved

Mr Lee as one of the Committee appointed to confer with Mr Wm Townsend in regard to the use of part a Portion of his premises for road purposes reported that no agreement had been made.

Mr Ruth moved that the sum of Ten Dollars be paid Mr Townsend for the use of said premises said sum to be in full payment for all past use and for future use until Jan 1st 1883 and to include said Townsend allowing the City the right to remove the gravel from said premises for street purpose free of charge. Secured by Lee and Carried.

On Motion Beardsley & Secured by Townsend that the Building Committee be instructed to erect a frame building in freedom near the Town Center for the use of the Fire Department in protecting Hook & Ladder Truck. Motion Carried

The Committee on Petition of Wm Chambers reported that no decision could arrived at until a survey

of the premises was made
and a line established

On Motion of Coats and Seconded
by Shaffer that the Street Com-
mittee be requested to examine
the foot Bridge on Broadway and
report as to its Safety Motion Carried

A request was made to the Council
that a gasoline Post be located
in front of the Presbyterian Church
On Motion, referred to Gas Committee

Water Works

On Motion of Ruth & Seconded by Shaffer
that a Committee consisting of Two
Councilmen, Mayor, Solicitor, and one
Citizen, be appointed to meet with
Mr J. A. Cloud, his Attorney and one
Citizen selected by Mr Cloud for the
purpose of framing a Contract
for Water Works. Motion Carried

Mr. Coats & Mr Townsend were appointed
to act on said Committee

On Motion of Beardsley & Seconded
by Ruth that the Mayor be Author-
ized to employ a janitor to take
care of City Buildings, Fire Hose &c
at a salary not to exceed
\$35. Per month - Motion Carried
over until next regular meeting

No further business the
meeting adjourned
