from this date

which was Seconded by Coats and Carried

Amending an Ordinance Entitled an Ordinance
Establishing a grade on Alliance Street between
the Center of Wth Union Street and the Cleveland and Pittsburgh
R. R. Passed 1st reading and on Motion of Coats Second
by Townsend that the rules be suspended to permit the
Ordinance to pass second and third reading and final
passage. Motioned Carried, Yeas 4 Nays being called
resulted as follows, Yeas Lee, Shaffer, Ruth, Coats
Townsend, Nays Beardsbly. Yeas 5 Nays 1. The Ordinance
passed its third reading and the vote on final pas-
sage stood as before Yeas 5 Nays 1 The Mayor declared
the Ordinance duly passed.
