 in Boarding prisoners, beg leave to submit  
 the following:

 M W Lowman has for 36 days board at  
 60 cts per day \$ 21.60  
 Over Charges on Same \$ 3.60  
 Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 1883 - 39 days @ 60<sup>c</sup> per day \$ 23.40  
 Over Charges on Same @ 10<sup>c</sup> per day 3.90  
 March 5 '83 7 days @ 60 per day \$ 4.20  
 Over charges on Same 70  
 April 5 '83 5 days @ 60<sup>c</sup> per day 3.00  
 Over Chgs on Same 50  
 Total Over Charges \$ 8.70

We also find in the Month of Jan 1883  
 J. S. Hogue has charged for eleven  
 days Board @ 60<sup>c</sup> per day 6.60  
 Over Charges on Same \$ 1.10

The following Resolution was offered by Mr Silvers

Be it Resolved by the Council of the incorporated village of Alliance Ohio that William J Beardsley be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to notify each male person between the ages of 21 & 55 years residing in the Corporation and not exempt by Law from the performance of labor upon the public highways to appear at a time and place specified in the notice and perform two days labor upon the Streets & Alleys of the Corporation as required by ~~law~~ ordinance and said Wm J Beardsley is hereby appointed, authorized, & instructed to advise oversee & superintend the performance of labor upon the Streets and Alleys by each person so required & notified to perform, such labor; and to give receipts to all persons who faithfully perform two days labor as aforesaid; said Wm Beardsley is further authorized and instructed to receive & receipt for the sum of Three Dollars in lieu of such labor on the part of any person wishing to make such payments

And to hand the City Solicitor a list of the names of persons who neglect or refuse to perform such labor when notified or to pay said sum in lieu thereof.

Williams moved that the amount \$3. specified in the resolution in lieu of two days labor be stricken out and \$2<sup>50</sup> be inserted. The motion was seconded by Silvers and Carriker -

The resolution was then on motion, laid on the table without further action until the next meeting.

The Solicitor to whom was referred the Bill dated March 5<sup>th</sup> 1883 for of M W Lowman for serving notices, on the Property holders on Arch Street Reported as follows -

For this kind of work the fees are not fixed by Statute and the officer is entitled to what his services were reasonably worth. As this is not a question of Law but one of fact I leave the worth amount to be determined by the Council.

Williams moved that M W Lowman be allowed \$15. for his services in notifying the Property owners on Arch Street. Which was seconded by Silvers. Mr Stanley moved an Amendment to make the amount \$25. - Seconded by Lee and lost by the following vote, <sup>for</sup> Stanley: Nays Williams, Silvers, Hawcutt Shaffer Lee Yeas 1 Nays 5. The vote on the Original Motion then stood
