Council Met in regular session - Mayor being absent. On Motion J. Stanley was appointed Chairman Protem

Minutes read and approved. A request from Hook and Ladder Company No One, was presented and read asking for Belts, Stove, Oil Fuel &c, which on Motion of Williams seconded by Silver referred to Fire Committee with power to act. Yeas & Nays being called the vote stood as follows Yeas 5 Stauley Williams Silver Fawcett Shaffer - yeas 5 nays none

Petition of Citizens asking the removal of obstructions from Alley west of Lot owned and known as Dressel Property, was read and on Motion referred to Committee on Streets with power to act as their judgement might dictate - Motion Carried. Mr Tanner being present. Asked

for instructions in regard to his duties
as Chief of Fire Department
