Council Convened in regular Session

Present Stanley, Williams, Sawcett
 Mayor Johnson Presiding
 Shaffer Secy
 Absent Silvers

Minutes of last meeting read and
 Approved

Mr Shaffer Chairman of the
 Fire Committee to whom was referred
 the matter of examining the condition
 of the fire engine reported too
 much mud in the Cistern. Other
 wise the engine would work all
 right.

Ordinances

The ordinance entitled an Ordinance
 to prevent Gaming & Gambling
 Passed to its third reading

An Ordinance Granting the right
 of way to the Cleveland, Youngstown
 And Pittsburgh Rail Way Company
 for side track or switch. Passed
 Second Reading

Lee Reported that a
 Gas post was needed on the
 corner of College & Liberty Street
 On motion referred to Gas Committee

Mr G B H Coates being present
 called the attention of the Council
 to the necessity opening a new
 road to the Cemetery to avoid

Crossing The Rail Road Track
 On motion of Shaffer, ^{Seconded by Fawcett} the matter was referred
 to the Street Committee.

Stanley Moved that a Committee be appointed
 to Measure Stone furnished ^{the biggest} by the Austen Flag
 Stone Co in 1882. Seconded by Lee and
 Carried - The Mayor Appointed Mrs
 Lee & Stanley

A Resolution was presented
 And read as follows Feb 18th 1884

Resolved ^{That} J. W. Strong of Salem
 be and he is hereby instructed to prepare
 plans and specifications, profiles,
 and estimates for the improvement
 of Arch Street, in accordance with
 the petition of the property owners
 of said Street, to the Council as soon
 as he can.

Stanley Moved that the resolution
 be adopted. Seconded by Shaffer
 and Carried by the following vote
 Williams Moved to Lay on the table
 Seconded by Fawcett & Lost

The vote on the On the original
 motion stood as follows, Yeas
 Stanley Shaffer Lee. Nays William
 Fawcett. Yeas 3 Nays 2. The
 Mayor declared the resolution
 adopted.

After the passage of
 the resolution Mr Fawcett
 asked the privilege of making
 a few remarks. Which on
 motion of Mr Williams was
 granted.

Mr Shaffer Moved

That Mr Williams be Authorized
to purchase Six Additional
Street Lamps, Secured by Stanley
and Carried by as Stanley William
Hawcutt Shaffer Lorr. Yeas five
Nays None
