Be it resolved by the Council of
the Incorporated Village of Alliance
that the Owners of Lots No 603, 604
605 606 607, 608 in Section Lamborn
Nos Addition to the Village of Alliance
Ohio be and they are now hereby
required and Ordered within Sixty
days after due notice of to them
of the passage of this resolution
to Construct a Side walk along
the East Side of said Lots No
603 604 605 606 607 + 608 in the ad-
dition aforesaid upon the Elevation
fixed by the Ordinance now in force
providing and Establishing a grade
on Liberty Street in said Village,
that said Side walk shall be Six
feet wide & Constructed of Stone
or Brick. Lee Moved that
the resolution be adopted
Seconded by Stanley & Carried
by the following Vote Yeas

Suspended to permit the Ordinance
to pass Second and Third Reading
and final passage Second by Williams
and Carried by the following vote
Yeas Stanley Williams Silver Fawcett
Lee Yeas 5 Nays none. The Ordin-
ance passed Second & Third reading and
the vote on final passage stood
As before Yeas 5 Nays none. The
Mayor declared the Ordinance duly
Passed
