On Motion of Williams Seconded by Stanley the fort grading done be done on West Main St Motion Carried

Williams Moved that the Street Committee be instructed to Confer with the ~~Trustees~~ Township Trustees for the purpose of obtaining the village portion of Bridge Tax Seconded by Hawcett & Carried

An Ordinance providing that the Marshal of this Village shall perform the duties of Street Commissioner. Passed first reading Stanley Moved that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass Second & Third reading and final Pass after second by Foscot & Carried by the following vote Yeas Galbreath Williams Prescott, Hawcett. & Stanley Yeas 5 + Nays none The vote on final passage stood as before Yeas 5 Nays none

Mayor Declared the Ordinance duly Passed.

Williams Moved that the building Committee be instructed to receive bids for the painting and varnishing of Council Chamber and report the same at next regular meeting for action of Council
Second by Fawcett & Carre

Williams Moved that the Street and Sidewalk Committee in connection with the Civil engineer are instructed to investigate the grades on the North Side of Main Street between Arch and the rail road west of same with a view of a change of same
Second by Stanley & Carre

An Ordinance to regulate the keeping of gun powder and other explosives and dangers combustible
passed 1st Reading

Stanley Moved that the Building Committee be instructed to proceed at once to have the City Lock up put in proper repair & condition.

On Motion of Williams Seconded by Stanley the City Solicitor was instructed to prepare an Ordinance Establishing a grade on Ash Street - Motion Carried

 the East Side of Lot No 88 in
 the Addition aforesaid upon
 the Elevation fixed by the Ord-
 nance now in force providing
 and establishing a grade on
 Liberty Street in said Village
 That said Sidewalk shall be
 Eight feet wide and constructed
 with Stone or brick

On Motion of Stanley Second by
 Hawcett the Resolution was adopted
 by the following vote Yeas Galbreath
 Williams Truscott Hawcett Stanley
 Yeas 5 Nays None

Stanley moved that the Chief fire
 Department be authorized to purchase
 the necessary connections for attaching
 fire Engine to fire plugs. Second by
 Hawcett Carried Yeas Galbreath
 Williams Truscott Hawcett Stanley
 Yeas 5 Nays None

Williams moved that Stanley
 in connection with Gas Com-
 mittee be instructed to see that
 the Gas + Gasoline Lamps be
 put in proper condition
 at once - Carried
