Minutes read and Approved
 Reports

The Committee to whom was referred the reports of the Clerk and Treasurer & of the Cemetery Trustees Reported as follows

We find the Treasurer has not submitted ^{his} report to Council since April 1880 1881 (which is required to be submitted Annually) At which time a balance of \$219.22 was in his hands as per report submitted at this time.

We find the last report made by the Secretary to the Council was April 19th 1880 at which time all moneys in his hands was reported paid as being paid over to Treasurer

We find Errors in footings of both Treasurer & Secretarys report Owing no doubt to Errors in Copying as the sum total appears to correct amounts, but are greater than warranted by the items specified

We find the Secretarys reports Balance on hand Apr 1 1881 of \$110⁰⁰. This amount is shown by his account at that time, & not by any report made to Council as no report has been made since April 19 1880 which should be made quarterly as required by Ordinance

For the information of the Council your Committee further reports that the Cemetery Trustees have failed to comply with the following requirements of the Ordinance

And recommend the Council to take some action in the matter with a view to legalizing said Board if same can be done.

The Ordinance requires that they should meet and elect a president, Secretary Treasurer, and Appoint a Superintendent who shall be confirmed by the Council.

The Clerk & Treasurer shall take the oath of Office in presence of the Council and give Bonds as follows the Clerk not less than \$500. + Treasurer not less than Two Thousand Dollars - All Money shall be paid out by Order of the Board & Warrant drawn by the Secretary. None of the Above requirements having ever been done Complied with, your Committee is at a loss to know whether we have any Cemetery Trustees, as the Ordinance provides that if they do not qualify within ten days from their Election the Office is vacant.

If the requirements of the Ordinance can yet be Complied with by the Trustees we recommend their reports as submitted to the Council be returned for correction and again be submitted after Board has been organized in compliance in all respects with the Ordinance creating said Board.
