Offered by Mr Williams the following
Resolution

Resolved Whereas it was deemed
Judicious and necessary by this Council
during the Early part of the Year by reason
of a surplus fund Accumulating in the
Village Treasury to the Credit of the Police
Fund by reason of the Scott Law, to put
on a Third Man at an Expense of
\$50⁰⁰ per Month, by reason of and whereas
The Courts have declared said Law un-
Constitutional and the Village Treasury thus
deprived of About \$1500⁰⁰ on which Cal-
culations had been made at the beginning
of the Year.

Therefore be it resolved
that in the judgement of this Council
under the Circumstances the Third Police-
man should be dispensed with imm-
ediately and thus saving to the Village
\$50⁰⁰ per Month in this department
Williams Moved the adoption of the
Resolution Secured by Fawcett.
Stanley Moved to Amend by laying
on the table until next Meeting
Secured by Galbreath Carried

Stanley Moved that the Building
Committee be instructed to

Act jointly with the Township Trustees
in the Matter of Repairing the Hall & Rooms
of the first floor of the Town Hall
Secured by Galbraith & Carried by the
following vote Yeas Galbraith Williams
Fawcett, Stanley Yeas 4 Nays none -

On Motion of Williams 2nd by Fawcett
The Clerk was instructed to send all
unpaid Bills for Constructing or Rep-
airing Sides to the Auditor to be
placed on the Tax Duplicate
Motion Carried

On Motion of Williams 2nd by Galbraith
The Solicitor was instructed to Cor-
respond with the Water Works Company
with reference to Certain Changes
in Contract. Carried
