 was passed to its third reading and
 on motion of Williams seconded by
 Stanley was put on its final passage
 with the following result

 Yeas 4 Nays None - The Mayor declared
 the Ordinance duly passed

A Ordinance to Establish the Grad
 of Oxford Street Passed Third Reading
 Williams that the Ordinance be put
 on final passage 2nd by Stanley
 & carried. Yeas Williams Hoer
