Salary fund will be short about  
\$1000.

Therefore be it resolved by  
the Council of the Incorporated  
Village of Alliance O in Session  
Assembled this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March  
1895; that application shall be  
made immediately to the Legislature

requesting an Act passed permitting the Corporation to issue Bonds to an Amount not Exceeding \$1000. to be placed to the Credit of Police & Salary Fund of Said Village Corporation  
Galbraith Moved the adoption of the resolution 2<sup>nd</sup> by Prescott and Carried by the following vote  
Yeas Galbraith Williams Hear  
Prescott Sawcett Yeas 5 Nays none

Galbraith Moved that the Mayor & Clerk be authorized to sign said resolution in behalf of Corporation and a copy of same to accompany the Bill sent to Legislature  
Second by Prescott & Carried

Mayor Appointed Galbraith, Williams & Hear to act as judges at the Special Election to be held Mar 14<sup>th</sup> 1885 in the South Prec

At the Special Election to be held March 14<sup>th</sup> 1885 The Mayor Appointed Galbraith, Hear, & ~~See~~ <sup>Williams</sup> to act as judges in the South Precinct & Prescott Sawcett & Stanley in the North precinct.

Williams Moved that the Matter of repairs of Side walk on South Liberty Street between Broadway & Oxford, be referred to Side walk Committee with instructions to act with out delay  
Motion Second by Galbraith & Carried

Resolved that J B Strawn  
be requested to turn over to the Mayor  
All Maps, notes of Surveys &c belonging  
to the Corporation, and be notified that  
his Services is dispensed with for the  
present & until will not be required

& Carried - Yeas 5 Halbreath Williams  
Here Foscott Strawn, Yeas 5 Nays none
