Whereas at a Special Election of the qualified ~~voters~~ Electors of the Village of Alliance Alliance O held March ~~5th~~ 14th 1885 in pursuance of an Ordinance passed February 16th 1885 the following Questions were submitted to said Electors to be voted on by them;

First Shall J. A. Cloud & Co Their Successors and Assigns be Authorized to Operate in the Village of Alliance to Supply said Village and its inhabitants with water?

Second Shall the Contract entered into between the Alliance Water works Company and the Village of Alliance as Authorized by an Ordinance passed Jan 5th 1885 be ratified?

And Whereas the whole number of votes cast at said Election was 545 of which number 505 voted yes and 39 "No" on the first question and 505 voted "yes" and 40 voted "No" on the second question.

Therefore be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Alliance O That it is hereby declared by said Council that the result of said Election was in favor of each of said Questions and each of said questions is hereby declared to have been Carried at said Election

On Motion Williams a Committee consisting of Herber Galbraith and Prescott was appointed to confer with Mrs Ward with reference to sidewalk tax assessed against her property. Motion Carried
