## An Ordinance

To authorize the Mayor and the Clerk to issue the bonds of The Village of Alliance O for the sum of One Thousand Dollars for the purpose of placing the same to the credit of the Police & Salary fund. Passed first reading Williams moved that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass 2nd & 3rd reading and put on final passage. Seconded by Galbraith and Carver. Yeas Galbraith Williams, Heer, Priscott, Sawcett, Stanley, yeas six nays none. The Ordinance was then read 2nd & Third time, and the vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 6 nays none. The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed.

The Old Council having completed their work, were adjourned by the Mayor. Sine Die. Mr Williams, Mr Sawcett & Mr Stanley retiring.

The Council Elect. being present came forward in answer to their names as follows M Earley, Jonathan Myres P & Keplinger. The Mayor administered the Oath of office to Jonathan Myres. Keplinger & Earley having previously been sworn.

The New Council then proceeded to Organize. With Mayor Johnson in the Chair. Upon Roll Call the following members responded to their names. Galbraith, Priscott, Earley, Myres, Keplinger, Heer.
