 & Salary Fund. Passed first reading  
 On Motion of Herr second by Replinger  
 the rules were suspended, Permitting  
 the Ordinance to pass second & third  
 reading & final Passage. Yeas Galbraith  
 Carley Replinger, Myers Herr. Yeas  
 5 Nays none. The Ordinance was  
 then read second & 3<sup>rd</sup> time and  
 the vote on final passage stood
