Ordinance To extend the Payment of Bonded Debt due Jan 1st 1886
 Herr Moved to Suspend the rules and that the Ordinance be read 2nd & 3rd time & put on final Passage 2nd

By Myers & Carried by the following Vote
 Was Galbreath Prescott Earley Myers Keplinger
 Ayes 6 Nays none. The Ordinance
 then passed 2nd & 3rd reading And the
 vote on final passage stood as before
 yeas 6 nays none. The Mayor declared
 the Ordinance duly passed

 yeas 6 nays none

 to Comply with the requirements of the
 Ordinance

On Motion Mr Myers was Authorized
 to Collect Sundry bills for Side Walk
 repairs, as to Work Performed by Mr Istair
 Ord by Heer & Carried
