Myers Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to Procure the Services of Mr Day to Assist him in Case of Mrs Campbell vs Alliance 2<sup>nd</sup> by Galbreath & Carried Yeas Galbreath Foscott, Earley, Myers, Kepslinger Ayeer Yeas 6 nays none.
