Ordinance  
To repeal an Ordinance Entitled an Ordinance Providing for and regulating the police department. Passed first reading Williams Move to Suspend the Rules: That the Ordinance Pass 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and final Passage. Secured by Earley & Carried by the following Vote Yeas Earley, Williams Hill Cassaday, Johnson Myers. Yeas 6 Nays none. The Ordinance then Passed 2<sup>nd</sup> and third Reading. And the Vote on final Passage resulted as before Yeas Earley, Williams, Hill Cassaday, Johnson Myers. 6 Yeas No Nays. The Ordinance was declare duly Passed.

The Mayor Submitted the name of Patrick Scaulin to serve on the Police force for the ensuing year Williams Moved that the Appointment of Mr Scaulin be Confirmed 2<sup>nd</sup> by Myers And lost Yeas Earley Williams. Hill Nays Cassaday Johnson. Myers. Yeas 3 nays 3.

Mayor Nominated F. Keromer Myers Moved to Confirm 2<sup>nd</sup> by Williams & Lost Yeas Earley Williams. Nays Hill Cassaday Johnson. Myers Yeas 2 Nays 4.

Johnson Moved that the Present Police Force be retained until the next regular meeting of the Council 2<sup>nd</sup> by Myers & Lost. Yeas Cassaday Johnson Myers. Nays Earley Williams Hill. Yeas 3 Nays 3. The Mayor decided the Motion Lost.
