Annual Report of Board of Health Submitted as follows

To the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance O. Gentlemen, herewith submitted the Annual ^{Report of the} ~~Report~~ of the Board of Health for the Year ending May 1st 1880.

Considerable Amount of work has been done ~~during~~ the year in trying to keep the Town in as Cleanly Condition as possible. A great many notices were issued to Parties to Clean up their grounds, and mostly responded to. We would call your attention to the Ditch along P. F. W. & C. & P. Rail Road to devise some place to get rid of the Obstructions along said ditch.

Early in Feb Dr Davidson our Health Officer died thereby leaving us without such Officer. On the 12th of Feb a meeting of the Board was called. Dr P. W. Walker was elected to fill the vacancy.

Williams Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance regulating the use of our Station Street in accordance with Survey
 2nd by Early + Carried

On Motion of Williams 2nd by Hill the Committee on Grades was instructed to employ Surveyor until next meeting

Myres Moved that a Levy of 2 Mills on the Dollar be made to pay an Bonded indebtedness 2nd By Johnson

Williams Moved to Amend by Striking out "2 Mills" and inserting "3 Mills." 2nd by Cassaday - Johnson Moved Lay on the Table until next meeting 2nd by Myres + Carried

Myres Moved that when we adjourn we adjourn to meet Monday Evening May 10th. Carried
