Street & Sanitary Fund \$1000.00 Police & Salary \$700.00 Water Fund \$300.00. Said Bonds to be issued in Sums of from \$100.00 to \$500.00 and bear interest at 6% Semianually, to be due Three years from date there of.

An Ordinance Providing for and fixing

 Same for the Year 1886. Passed its 1st
 Reading. Williams Moved that the rule
 be suspended, that the Ordinance Pass 2nd
 Reading 2nd By Johnson & Carried Yeas
 Earley, Williams, Hill, Cassaday, Johnson
 Myers Yeas 6 Nays None. Johnson Moved
 the Ordinance be read by its title 2nd
 by Hill & Carried. Johnson Moved
 to suspend the rules to permit the ordinance
 to pass to its 3rd reading and final
 Passage 2nd by Myers & Carried

yeas Earley Williams Hill, Cassaday, Johnson
Myres, yeas 6 nays, Ordinance Passed 3rd reading
And the vote on final Passage resulted
as before yeas 6 nays none, The Mayor
declared the Ordinance duly Passed

Williams Moved that the Clerk be authorized to Certify
to the County Auditor of the passage of the Ordinance
providing for fixing rate of Taxation.
2nd by Myres & Carried

Passed First reading an Ordinance to Establish
a grade on South Webb Street

An Ordinance to provide for the Con-
struction and repair of Sidewalks and for the
Collection of the same Costs of such Construction
or repairs, Passed 1st reading.

On Motion Williams 2nd by Hill the Ordinances
were Suspended. Yeas Earley Williams
Hill Cassaday Johnson, Myres, yeas 6
nays none The Ordinance Passed its 2nd
Reading - Myres Moved to Sus^p the rules
to permit the Ordinance to pass 3rd reading
& Placed on final Passage. 2nd by Williams
& Carried Yeas Earley, Williams, Hill, Cassa-
day, Johnson, Myres Yeas 6 nays none
The vote on final Passage resulted as before
Yeas 6 nays none
