 For less than 30 days the Charges would be \$3.00 ^{Pr Week} from 30 to 90 days \$2.00 Pr Week After first 90 days \$1.50 - Medical, Transportation & Clothing Expenses to be paid by Alliance And none to be received under sixteen and over sixty years of age.
