 We will light Main Street with (8) ^{lights} Same
 as the Electric lights used by the Pitts. &
 Wayne & Chicago Rail ^{road} Co use in their
 R R yard. - All night for 40 @ 50
 Ps lamps pr night during every night
 in the month. Or if you decide otherwise
 will light every night in the month
 until Twelve O'clock for Ten Dollars
 pr month 8 lamps.

Resolved that in the opinion of this Council it has become necessary to establish a main or trunk sewer on Market Street commencing at the Summit of said Street which is 100 feet east of Freedom Street and running westward on said Street to Mechanic Street and emptying into the water course or stream on said Mechanic St. And that the Cost and Expense of Constructing same shall be according to Benefits.

On Motion of Johnson the resolution offered by Mr Williams was layd over until the next meeting.

An Ordinance

Defining the duties of and regulating the Street Commissioner Passed third Reading
On Motion of Johnson 2nd by Myers its final passage was deferred until next meeting

An Ordinance to Prohibit Ale, Beer and Porter Houses other places where Intoxicating liquors are sold at retail Passed 2nd Reading

Williams Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to draw Ordinance Establishing a grade on Columbiana Street between Depot & Liberty Streets 2nd by Earley & Carver

On Motion of Williams 2nd by Earley the Solicitor was instructed to draft an Ordinance Est^d to Change the grade on Avenue & Ely Streets made necessary the C & P Rail road Crossing

Passed First Reading
An Ordinance.

To Authorize the Mayor
And Clerk of the Incorporated Village of
Alliance to issue the bonds of said
Village for the purpose extending the time
of payment of the Bonded debt of said
Village due Sept 1st 1886

Johnson Moved that the Crossing located
on West Main Street near the property of
Mrs Spicer remain in its present location
2nd by Williams & Carried

On Motion of Johnson 2nd by Williams
A Committee of 3 was appointed to
investigate the Matter of Sidewalks
on the North Side of ^{south} Main Street near
Rail Road Crossing. The Mayor
Appointed Johnson Williams & Hill.

Williams Moved that the Bill
of G. M. Stanley for lighting Gasoline
Lamps be laid over until next
Meeting Carried
