Offered by Mr Williams the following Resolution

Resolved that the gas Committee is authorized and instructed to Contract with the Alliance Gas Light Co for the lighting of Main Street with Eight Electric lights from Liberty to Mt Union Streets, One light to be placed at the intersection of each Cross Street between and including said Liberty & Mt Union Streets. Said lights are to be contracted for at the 40[¢] pr lamp for all night or 30[¢] pr lamp for half the night Half nights to Estimate from dark to Midnight or from midnight til Morning Said Contract to be made til May 1st 1887 And the time of lighting night or parts of a night to be lit, to be Optional with the Committee and the Council. For the Expence of Said lighting the Committee is instructed to make a Special Assessment on the property on Main Street benefited by Same.

Williams Moved the adoption of the Resolution Seconded by Johnson.

Johnson Moved to Amend by Substituting Finance Committee instead of Gas Committee. 2nd by Earley & Carried

The Resolution was then adopted as Amended by the following Vote Yeas Earley, Williams, Hill, Cassaday, Johnson, Myres. Yeas 6 nays none

— Called for final passage —

An Ordinance Entitled An Ordinance to prohibit Ale. Beer, and porter Houses and other places where intoxicating Liquors are sold at retail. Having been previously read three times was Taken from the Table and put upon its final passage

Johnson moved to Amend Section Two (2) by inserting after the words "Twenty Dollars" and imprisoned in the County Jail not less than ten days nor more than twenty days 2nd by Myres.

Myres moved to Amend Said Amendment by Striking out the words "County Jail" and inserting "Village Prison" in Lieu of Same 2nd by Hill + Carried

A Vote on the Original Amendment As Amended was Taken resulting As follows Yeas Earley Hill Cassaday, Johnson Myres Williams. Yeas 5 Nays none

Johnson moved to further Amend Section 2 by inserting After the words "One Hundred Dollars" and imprisoned in the Village Prison not less than 20 days nor more than 30 days. 2nd by Myres + Carried Yeas 5 Nays none.

The Ordinance was then put upon its final passage ^{as amended} with the following result Yeas Earley, Williams, Hill, Cassaday Johnson Myres. Yeas Six Nays none The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed
