Council Chamber Alliance O Aug 20 1886

Council met in Special Session pursuant to a call regularly made by the following notice having been served upon each member of the Council personally by a copy, to wit:

To M. Earley R. G. Williams Geo. Hills
J. S. Cassaday, E. H. Johnson and Jonathan Myers
You are hereby notified a special meeting of the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio will be held at the Council Chamber in said Village this Evening 7.30 O'clock P.M. The Meeting aforesaid is for the purpose of reconsidering the action of said Council in the passage of an Ordinance and for the purpose of duly passing an Ordinance, Entitled "An Ordinance to prohibit Ale beer and porter Houses and places where Intoxicating Liquors are sold at retail" And for the transaction of unfinished business.

All the Members of Council were present as follows, Earley, Williams, Hills, Cassaday, Johnson, Myers.

Mayor Coxen Presiding

The Mayor stated the Object of the Meeting as set forth in the above Call.

Johnson Moved that the Council reconsider the vote whereby an Ordinance was passed Aug 9th 1886

but not published as required
 by law. Entitled "An Ordinance
 To prohibit ~~prohibit~~ Ale beer and
 Porter Houses and places where in-
 toxicating liquors are sold at retail.
 The Motion was seconded by Myers
 and Carried by the following vote
 Yeas, Earley Williams Hill Cassady
 Johnson Myers. Yeas 6, Nays none.

After due consideration of the
 vote aforesaid Johnson Moved that
 the Ordinance be put upon its
 final passage. Seconded by Cassady
 and Post. As follows Yeas Williams
 Hill. Nays Earley Cassady Johnson
 Myers. Yeas 2 Nays 4.

Whereupon the following
 Ordinance was read by the Clerk

An Ordinance
 To prohibit Ale, beer and porter houses
 and other places where intoxicating liquors
 are sold at retail

Section 1. Be it Ordained by the Council of the
 Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio
 That it shall be unlawful for any person
 or persons to keep within the limits of the
 said Village, any Ale, beer or porter house
 or any place where intoxicating liquors
 are sold at retail, for any purpose or
 in any quantity, provided that nothing
 herein contained shall prevent any
 regular druggist from selling liquors
 upon prescriptions issued in good faith
 by reputable physicians in Active
 practice or for exclusively known
 Mechanical, pharmaceutical or
 Sacramental purposes.

Section 2 Any person or persons violating
 any of the provisions of this Ordinance

Shall, upon Conviction Thereof, be fined for the first offense not less than ten (~~\$10~~) Dollars ⁽⁸¹⁰⁾, nor more than fifty Dollars (\$50) And for each subsequent offense not less than twenty five Dollars (\$25), nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100).

Item B. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force when days have elapsed after its passage and legal publication.

~~Johnson~~ moved that the rules be suspended and said Ordinance be read the second time, which motion was seconded by Myers. And Carried by the following vote. Yeas Earley Hill Cassaday Johnson Myers Nays Williams. Yeas 5 Nays 1 The said Ordinance was thereupon read by the Clerk the second time.

Johnson moved that the rules be suspended and that the said Ordinance be read the third time and put to a vote upon its final passage which motion was seconded by Hills and Carried by the following vote Yeas Earley Hill Cassaday Johnson Myers. Nays Williams. Yeas 5 Nays 1

The said Ordinance, was thereupon read by the Clerk the third time.

A vote was then taken upon the final passage of the said Ordinance with the following result. Yeas Earley, Williams, Hill, Cassaday, Johnson Myers. Yeas Six Nays none. The Mayor then declared the Ordinance Alike passed.

Reports

The Committee to whom was referred the matter of side walk on East main Street on the South of Pa RR track made the following report. That we recommend that

The town furnish wood or tile
As the Rail Road Co May desire
They to put it down and do the
Necessary work by filling up to
grade the side walk and cover it
with Crushed Stone.

of Same - Yeas Earley Williams, Hill,
Cassaday, Johnson Myers Yeas 6
Nays None.

Williams Moved that the Vote Taken
for the payment Mr Petersons Bill
for Gasoline light be reconsidered
2nd by Myers & Carried

Said Bill of Mr Peterson be
Amended by Taking off 5 nights
lighting 2nd by Cassaday & Carried
