Be it resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance that the Street Commissioner be ordered to entirely quit work, there being no funds in the Treasury to pay for same and no orders will be drawn for any work done by the Street Commissioner — Earley Moved the adoption of the resolution 2<sup>nd</sup> by Myers & Carried Yeas Earley Hills Cassaday Johnson, Myers Yeas 5 nays 2 none

The Matter of Charges preferred  
Policeman Emery Osborn was Called  
up and read as follows:

To the Mayor and Council of the

Mr the undersigned do  
hereby Charge Emery Osborn with Dereliction  
of duty as will appear in the following  
Specifications

1<sup>st</sup> In taking a prisoner John Loftis from  
the prison to Mt Union Street to visit J W Coulter  
or some other purpose without Authority so  
to do.

2<sup>nd</sup> In taking Mrs Bisler to see a Physician  
to get a Certificate for Mr Bisler, Neglecting  
his duty during the time, Also in refusing  
or neglecting to Arrest Bisler and lock him  
up when Ordered so to do by the Mayor

3<sup>rd</sup> General Conduct as policeman such as to  
Warrant Citizens in belief that said Emery Osborn  
is in sympathy with those who do not respect  
or Obey the law and doing all in his  
power to shield law breakers from Exposure  
and punishment in violation of his obligation  
as an Officer of this Village.

Myers then Moved that Policeman Emery Osborn be discharged from the Police force Secured by Earley & Carried Yeas Earley Hills Cassaday, Johnson Myers - Yeas 5 Nays None.

Myers Moved that Mr Osborn be Officially Notified of his removal from Office Dnd by Earley & Carried

The Committee to <sup>whom</sup> was referred the Petition for Lamp on Corner of South Webb & Cambridge Streets Reported favorably

Earley Moved that a lamp be placed on Said location, Dnd by Cassaday and Carried - Yeas Earley Hill Cassaday Johnson Myers Yeas 5 Nays None.

Myers Moved that the Clerk draw an Order in favor of Emery Osborn for \$4.50. Balance due for police service Dnd by Hills & Carried. Yeas Earley Hill, Cassaday, Johnson, Myers Yeas 5 Nays None
