The Second Class, ^{and} Asking that the Council proceed to take the necessary steps toward to procure said advancement. On Motion of Johnson seconded by Myers the following Resolution was adopted. "Resolved the Mayor be instructed to give legal notice to the Electors of the Village of Alliance that at the next annual Municipal Election of said Village the following question will be submitted for decision: Shall the Village of Alliance be advanced to a City of the Second Class. Yeas Early Hills Johnson Myers.

Johnson Moved that the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Offer a reward of \$50. for the arrest and Conviction of the party or parties who destroyed the shade trees on Arch & Mid Union Streets on the night of March 16th 87. Seconded by Early, Carrick Yeas Early Hills Johnson Myers Yeas 4 Nays None
