THE CLERK OF THE INCORPORATED Village of Alliance, O., will sell at public auction on Monday, March 28th, 1887, commencing at 2:30 o'clock P. M. of said day, at the office of the Mayor in said Village, Bonds of said Village to the amount of \$4,000, each bond bearing interest at six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, redeemable three years from their date.
