An Ordinance

To Authorize the Alliance Gas And Oil Company its Successors or Assigns to lay and maintain pipes in Streets Alleys Avenues & Public Grounds in the Village of Alliance for Certain Gas & Oil purposes And under the Conditions Ordinance Herein Stated. Read the Second time. Williams Moved that the rules requiring Ordinances to be read on three different days be suspended that the Ordinance pass third reading & final Passage. Seconded by Weybricht And lost Yeas Weybricht Williams Nays Cassaday Smith.

An Ordinance

Creating a Board of Commissioners of Sowers. Passed 2nd Reading Williams Moved to suspend the rules requiring Ordinance to be read on three different days, that the Ordinance be read the third time and placed on final passage 2nd by Cassaday & Carried Yeas Weybricht Williams Cassaday Smith Yeas 4 Nays none. The Ordinance was read the third time. And the vote on its final Passage resulted Mr Selme Yeas 4 Nays none. The Ordinance was declared duly passed

At Cassaday Moved That The Motion to Suspend the rules requiring Ordinances to be read on three different days be reconsidered Seconded by Williams and Carried Yeas Weybrich Williams Cassaday Smith. Yeas 4 Nays none

Passage Cassaday Moved that ^{Sec 6 of} the Ordinance be so amended as to read \$1000. instead of \$500. 2nd Yeas & Only Smith & Carried.
