Council Met in regular Session

Mayor Coxen Presiding

Members Present Weybacht Williams Hills
Smith. Absent Cassaday.

On Motion the reading of minutes was
dispensed with.

Reports

A report was submitted signed by W A Smith
Secretary of the fire department stating
that a called meeting of the was held June 27th
for the purpose of electing a Chief resulting
in the reelection of A. G. Tanner to serve
as Chief of said department for the
ensuing year.

On Motion report accepted.

The Gas Committee reported that 114
lights of glass broken in Gasoline Street
Camps.

Hills moved to instruct the Gas Committee
to procure said glass at the expense
of the Village. Ind by Smith & Carver.

Passed 3 Readings. Ordinance

To Establish Grade On Patterson Street
between Mechanic Street and the Eastern
line of the Corporation. Read the third
time - And On Motion Put on final
Passage resulting Yeas Weybacht
Williams Hills Smith, Yeas 4
Nays None.

The Mayor declared the Ordinance
July passed.

Passed 3 Reading an Ordinance to Establish the
grade on Mechanic Street between

between Hesters Avenue and Columbia Street and between Oxford Street and Grant Street. The Ordinance was put on its final passage resulting Years Weybret Williams Hills Smith Years 4 Nays None. The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed.

An Ordinance Locating Certain fire plugs therein designated read third time and placed on final passage and carried by the following vote, Years Weybret Williams Hills Smith Years 4 Nays None. The Ordinance was declared duly passed.

An Ordinance Entitled An Ordinance Locating Certain Fire Plugs therein designated. Was Read the ~~second~~^{2nd ed} time Weybret moved to suspend the rules requiring Ordinances to be read on three different days, that the Ordinance be read the third time and placed on its final passage Secured by Smith and carried Years Weybret Williams Hills Smith Years 4 Nays None. The Ordinance was read the third time and vote on its final passage resulted as before Years 4 Nays none. The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed.

The Finance Committee to whom was referred the matter of purchasing Stone for Street Crossings. Not being prepared to report was granted further time.

Williams Moved The Side walk Committee
And Solicitor be instructed to prepare resolutions
for the Construction of Sidewalks ~~on Lots~~
On Each Side of Treadon Street from Broadway
to Rounberry. Also lot on Arch Street and
on ~~West~~ Side of Keplinger Block on Linden
Avenue. Motion Carried.

Resolution to Call an Election for Marshal & Prohibition Ordinance
Smith Moved the adoption of the following Resolu-
tion.

Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated
Village of Alliance O that an Election shall be
held within fifteen days from ~~date~~ this date
for the purpose of Electing a Village Marshall
to fill the unexpired term of J Smeltz
resigned. Day to be fixed and Election
to be Called by the Mayor.

At the same time
and place the question of the repeal
of the present Prohibitory Ordinance
be Submitted to the qualified Voters
Electors of the Corporation. -

Ballots to be printed as follows
Repeal of Prohibition Ordinance - Yes
Repeal of Prohibition Ordinance - No.

Weybacht seconded the motion to
adopt the resolution which was
Carried by the following vote
Yeas Weybacht Williams Smith
Nays Hills Yeas 3 Nays One

Street Commissioner White
Reported the Names of 76 Persons who
had failed to perform two days ^{poll tax} labor
on the Streets after being duly notified.

Williams Moved the Solicitor be
instructed to notify Each One that
that a Settlement must be made

within 5 days or legal proceeding
would be commenced for the collection
of same. Second by Weybrech
And Carried

On Motion An Order was authorized
drawn on the treasury for \$150 for the
purpose of notifying Poll Tax delinquents
drawn in favor of the Solicitor

On Motion the matter of establishing
grade on South Webb Street was
referred to Grade Committee

Weybrech Moved that the ~~identities~~
of Centers to Alliance ^{as plotted} be accepted
by the ^{Council} providing it conforms with
adjoining ~~additions~~ the Streets and
Alleys of said Addition conform to
those in adjoining addition of Teeters
Lamborn & Co. Second by Smith
And Carried Yeas Weybrech Williams
Hills, Smith. Yeas 4 Nays None.
