Smith offered the following Resolution

Whereas the Prohibitory Ordinance has been a second time submitted to the People and received a second emphatic endorsement by a large majority of their votes. Therefore,

Resolved that it is the sense of this Council that said Ordinance should be rigidly enforced and that we will support the Mayor and Police Officers in every legitimate effort they make toward the aforesaid enforcement of the same.

Resolved that all reasonable costs of prosecution under said Ordinance not otherwise provided for shall be paid by the Village.

Smith Moved the Adoption of the Resolution Second by Cassaday - Williams Moved to Strike Amend by striking out the words in the part of the resolution "not otherwise provided for" Second by Weybrich and lost.

A Yeas & Nays vote was then taken on the resolution resulting as follows Yeas Weybrich Hills Cassaday Smith - Nays Williams Yeas 4 Nays One.

Williams asked that his vote be reconsidered and recorded Yeas on the first part of the resolution and Nays on the second. On Motion request granted and the Clerk instructed to so record the same.

Offered by Mr. Weybricht the following Resolution
Whereas it is the Sense of this Council that
better protection should be given to our Citizens
in Crossing and recrossing the Rail Road, both
at the Park Street Crossing and at the Patterson
Street Crossing

Therefore be it Resolved that
the Penna. Company Operating the Pittsburg
Fort Wayne [&] Chicago Rail Way be requested
to place a watchman at the above named
Park Street Crossing and the same Company
Operating the Cleveland + Pittsburgh Railway
be requested to place a watchman at the
above named Patterson Street Crossing.

And further that General A B Star and
General John Thomas be severally notified
by the Clerk of this Action

Smith Moved the adoption of the
Resolution 2nd by Hills and Carried

Petition was Presented by E H Johnson
and others asking that the well on Rosebury
Street near Mt Union Street be Cleaned
out and and supplied with new
Pump & Watering Trough.

Weybrich Moved that the Prayers of said
Petitioners be granted and that
Street Committee be instructed to
make the necessary repairs to said
Well. Seconded by Cassaday and
Carried.
