building Submitted the following
report from Guy Selden Architect

To the Honorable City Council of Alliance,
Gentlemen

On Thursday Oct 6th With the assis-
tance of B F Wright and J B Brown and other
Made an examination of the M E Church of
Grove City.

I find that on account of a poorly designed
and constructed roof, that the East and
West Walls are out of Plumb. This Roof
I Examined about a year ago at the
request of One of the Members of Said
Church and then suggested that ~~four~~
iron rods be run across the Auditorium
and and fastened to the foot of the principal
rafters. This has been done in a very thorough
and Substantial Manner, and will, I feel
Certain prevent any further bulging of
the Side Walls.

I find NO Indications whatever that there
has been any recent giving way of any
part of this building.

I would suggest as a precautionary
measure that the Conductors on the East
Side of ~~the~~ be replaced by new ones.
and that all the roof and Surface water
be conveyed away from the building to prevent
its soaking into the Ground at the foundation
as it now does.

I would further suggest that the
top of the Chimney on the East
Side of the building be repaired
and covered with a piece of Flag
Stone to prevent the brick from
becoming loose and that Said
Chimney be thoroughly grouted to the roof with
Iron Rods.
