Ordinance

To Change and Establishth grade on
Freedom Street Passed its Third reading
and Placed on final passage with the
following result.

The Mayor declared the Ordinance
duly passed

An Ordinance to Locate
Certain Fire Plugs Was read
the second time - Weybrock moved that
the rules requiring Ordinances to be read
on three different days be suspended
and the Ordinance read the third time
and put on final passage. Second
by Hill & Carried Yeas Weybrock
Williams Hills Cassady Smith Yeas
5 Nays None - The Ordinance was read
the third time and the vote on final passage
stood Yeas Weybrock Williams Hills Cassady
Smith Yeas 5 Nays None The Mayor declared
the Ordinance duly passed.

Weybrich Moved that a Special Committee of Three be Appointed by the Mayor for the purpose of Dividing the City of Alliance into wards. Seconded by Hills and Carried ~~Yes~~

The Mayor Appointed on Said Committee Weybrich Williams and Cassaday.

Williams Moved that the Water Committee be instructed to Make necessary repairs on the City Hydrant. Carried

Smith Moved that the Council receive bids for supplying the Town Hall with Coal for the ensuing Winter and that the Clerk give notice to dealers that bids will be received until the next regular Council Meeting for furnishing same. Motion Carried.

The Mayor reported that a vacancy had occurred in Board of Sewer Commissioners by the resignation of Mr S Shimp and Nominated W L Parth to fill said vacancy subject to confirmation by the Council. Williams Moved that W L Parth's Appointment of W L Parth as a Member of the Board of Sewer Commission in place of S Shimp Resigned be Confirmed by the Council. Seconded by Weybrich & Carried

Weybricht Moved that the Matter of furnish the Freedom Fire Dept with a stove be referred to the fire
