Committee is hereby instructed to Confer with the Township Trustees with reference to Ballot Boxes necessary to be used for the Holding of Elections by reason of Extra wards being formed and that they are hereby instructed to secure same if after investigation it is found to be their duty. They are hereby authorized to secure the necessary desks and chairs for the Council Chamber for the accomodation of the incoming Council

Offered by Mr Cassaday the following Resolutions Resolved That Any Expenses incurred, or that may have occurred, in the ~~prosecutions of~~ in the Obtaining of Evidence in the prosecution of Cases under the Prohibitory Ordinance be paid by the Mayor out of fines collected in such Cases. Williams Moved That the Solicitor be instructed to draw an Ordinance regulating the Construction of buildings on Main Street from the The dept West to the Crossing of the Alliance Lake Erie and Southern Rail Road. Seconded by Hill & Carried

On Motion of Heybrock the Chairman of the Gas Committee was instructed to Confer with Mr Brait in regard to the Amt of Gas Consumed in his office Seconded by Cassaday & Carried

On Motion The Matter of Keeping up fire in the Engine Room be referred to the Chief of the fire department Carried

On Motion the Clerk was Authorized to procure the necessary Poll Books for the Coming Spring Election

Cassaday Moved That the Solicitor be Authorized to procure what assistance he thought necessary in obtaining Evidence in the Russell Case, Seconded by Heybrock and Carried Yeas 10 Nays 7
