### An Ordinance

To provide for the division of the Village of Alliance into wards and to establish the boundaries and designations of the same, was read the third time, Cassaday moved that it be taken on its final passage. Carried The yeas & nays being called The vote

on the final Passage of the Ordinance resulted as follows Yeas Mybrich Hills Cassaday Smith. Yeas 4 Nays None. The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly Passed.

Mybrich Moved that a Committee Consisting of the Entire Council be Appointed to Select And Obtain Voting Places for the Comm in Each ward for the Coming Election. And report the Same at the next Meeting. Seconded by Cassaday & Carried.

Cassaday Moved that the Clerk be instructed to Notify the Superintendant of the Alliance Water Works Co. of the passage of An Ordinance Localizing Two Water Hydrants on Eli Street. Requesting that They proceed as soon as practicable to Lay the Main. Seconded by Smith & Carried.

On Motion the Care of Firemans Hall was put into the Charge of the Chief of the fire department.
