 Health for the last year. As usual a large
 amount of work was done in the way of cleaning
 up, but owing to the great need of Sewerage
 a large amount of Stagnant water and Slush accu-
 mulated in the lower parts of the City especially
 along Rail Roads - We would again Appeal
 to your honorable body to hasten a System of
 Suerage ~~to~~ During last year fall the Sues
 we have were thoroughly washed out

The Board adopted a series of Rules
 and regulations for the Care and cleaning
 of Privy vaults & Cess Pools. Had them printed
 on Cards and properly posted throughout the
 City. A lot of work was done on the
 Arlington House property in the shape of a
 drain at an Expense of \$15.75 The Same
 to be charged on the Tax duplicate
