Reports of Standing Committees
Called for.

On Approval of Bills,
Mr Johnson Chairman of the finance Committee
Reported that the Committee had received the Bills
Too Late for Examination in time to be acted
upon at this Meeting. And asked further time
Granted

Mr Earley Chairman of the Street & Comm
To Whom was referred The Arch Street Paving

Petition asked for an extension of time to report which was granted. He also reported the ~~bad~~ Condition of the Streets through out the City and advised that some immediate repairs be made in order to avoid litigation which had already been threatened.

The Water Committee asked further time to report on Petition for water Main on North Liberty Granted

Mr Vick Chairman of the Public Lights Committee Reported that the Gas used by in Squire Stilwell's Office Passed through the Meter belonging to the City Hall and that he wished to have his Share apportioned. That he might pay it. On Motion referred to the Gas Committee.

President Pennock Called the Attention of Council to the Matter of Contracting for Gasoline lights for the present year. As the present Contract was about to expire. On Motion referred to Committee on Public lights

A Communication was received from the Fire Department in Session in the adjoining Hall Asking for the presence of Mr Sefer and Mr Betts of the fire Committee for the purpose of Council.

On Motion of Mr Johnson The fire department Committee was Excused. Mr Sefer and Mr Betts retired to fireman's Hall

Mr Williams in behalf of the Sidewalk Committee said that he was not prepared to make a full report, but had a partial list of Owners of walks that should be repaired.

Mr ~~Earley~~ ^{Betts} Called the attention of the Council to the bad condition of the streets being filled with tin cans &c - Referred to the St Commissioner.

The Fire Committee having returned from meeting with the Fireman. Mr Seft reported that ~~it~~ ^{was} ~~the~~ request of the fire department that Mr Bush resign as a member of the Fire department Committee, otherwise the fire department would disband.

The Committee to whom was referred the matter of preparing a Code of Rules, not being prepared to submit the same in full. was continued until the next meeting.

Mayor Chapman Announced that he was ready to submit his appointments for the Police force subject to their confirmation by the Council. He also suggested that three in addition to the Marshal should constitute the force.

Johnson Moved that three Policemen be Appointed Secured by Bush and Carried by the following vote Pennock, Betts, Bush. Johnson Jones Miller Seft Williams Drake Nays Earley Yeas 9 Nays one.

The Mayor nominated Elmer Carson as one of the Policemen. Subject to the confirmation of the Council. Mr Williams Moved that the nomination of Mr Carson be Confirmed Secured by Jones and Carried. Yeas Pennock Bush Johnson, Jones, Miller Williams Nays Earley, Betts, Seft Drake. Yeas Six Nays 4. The nomination was declared duly Confirmed.
