


Examine Certain nuisance between South Webb Street and Morgan Street. On Thursday 6:30 P.M. - Motion Carried

Mr Bush Called the attention of the Council to a nuisance existing between South Webb and Liberty Streets, which on motion of Jones was referred to the Street Committee with instructions to file if required.
