

Council Chamber June 18th 1888
 Council Met in regular Session

On Account of the Absence of President Pennock
 Council was Called to Order and Presided over
 by Vice President Williams.

Members Present Betts, Bush, Earley, Jones,
 Johnson, Miller Vick Williams.
 Absent Sefert Pennock.

Minutes read and approved

On Motion of Mr Bush. Mr Johnson of the Finance
 Committee was instructed to select such person as
 he saw fit to accompany him to Canton for the purpose
 of conferring with the Clerk of courts in regard to
 the Bill of Costs rendered in the Russell Case
 Second by Betts & carried

Treas Fee reported that he had received from
 the Mayor for fines & License Collected \$125. and
 asked the same be apportioned. Johnson
 Moved that \$75⁰⁰ be apportioned to the General
 Fund and \$50⁰⁰ to the Police & Salary Fund
 Second by Betts & carried

Mr Betts in behalf of the Committee to whom
 was referred the matter of receiving bids for Pub-
 lishing Ordinances &c Reported \$1.00 Per Square
 from each of the City Papers for the first insertion
 and 50cts Per Lineal Square for each Subsequent
 Insertion. On Motion layed on the
 Table until the next meeting

Mr Vick Member of the Committee on lights reported
 that he had received 2 Bids for furnishing
 Material & c + lighting Gasoline Lights. One
 James Moyer @ 70cts Per Post Per Month
 and 2 from Mr Stanley. One at 85⁰⁰ Per
 Lamp Per Month and one at \$100 Per Lamp
 Per Month. On Motion layed over to next
 meeting

Mr Jones in behalf of the Committee to whom was referred the Matter of Purchasing Police Supplies, Reported the Purchase of Two Whips
3 Maces 3 leather revolvers Pockets and 3 Police Calls Amounting to \$11.20 Report accepted

On Motion of Mr Jones Seconded by Mr Johnson the Solicitor was instructed to Prepare an ordinance Establishing the grade on South Liberty Street from Broadway to Summit Carried

Mr Bush Moved that the Solicitor be instructed to draw an Ordinance Establishing a grade on Clifford Street from Morgan Street on the East to the Corporation line on the West Seconded by Vick and Carried

Johnson Moved that the Ordinance Passed by the Council at a previous Meeting Entitled An Ordinance to Amend Section 3 of An Ordinance to Prohibit Ale Beer and Porter Houses and Other places where intoxicating liquors are sold at retail. be Published in both of the City Papers Seconded by ^{Mr} Betts & Carried

Mr Vick Moved that a Committee of Three of Council be appointed to Confer with a like Committee from Arch Street to look after the Minor details in reference to the Paving of Arch Street and look after the General interests of the Enterprise and report all deliberations to Council for their Consideration. Seconded by Jones & Carried

The President appointed Earley, Vick and Bush. the Said Committee.

Jones moved that the Superintendent of Water Works Company be notified of the passage of an Ordinance extending the water main from Park St West along Prospect Street to the Corner of Prospect and Mount Union, also extending of water main from Oxford South along Liberty St
 Locating Hydrants at Corner of Prospect and Mount Union, and Corner of Summit and Liberty St
 Second by Betts Carried

First Reading An Ordinance fixing the time and place of the meeting of Council of the City of Alliance.

First Reading

Mr Betts of the fire department committee read a report from the Chief of the department reporting progress as to its organization and asking that some necessary supplies be purchased - On motion report was accepted and the Fire Committee was instructed to purchase the needed supplies

On Motion The Fire Committee was instructed to investigate the matter of Compensation of the Chief of the fire department and Assistants and report to Council
 Motion Carried.
