an agreement as would justify this Council  
in granting to them the Franchise sought.  
But with the understanding that should it  
be unable to arrive at satisfactory results  
with said Company it be at liberty to consid-  
er the Proposition of the other Company

A vote was then taken on the resolution as amended resulting Yeas, ~~Vick~~ Betts, Carley, Sefert Miller Vick Nays Jones Johnson Bush Yeas 5 Nays 3.
